- → Photo frame in BMW BERLIN MARATHON design for your special photo for all marathon fans and, after the finish, especially for participants. The photo frames can be shared via social media and popular messenger services
- → FAQ
- → Interactive route maps with route navigation along the route, e.g., to individual cheering points
- → Tracking: Save favorites and follow up to 25 participants via live tracking and live rankings
- → Search for individual participants and clubs
- → Push notifications throughout the race weekend, especially for participants

RACE MATERIAL

You'll receive your race material only at the MARATHON EXPO and only personally upon presentation of your start card and ID.

You'll need

- → your start card → which you received by email and which is available for download in your user account under "My registrations"
- → your ID

You'll get

- → athletes wristband → will be put on you at the entrance and may not be taken off until you have finished on race day
- → your personal bib number → may not be altered in any way and is not permitted to be given to another person
- → transponder for timekeeping on the back of your bib number → do not bend
- → goodie bag with information & treats from our sponsors
- → Optional, if booked with your registration, you'll receive a transparent clothing bag, to drop-off your stuff on race day → can not be booked subsequently!
- → Pre-ordered extras from the event collection or bib number magnets will be handed out with your bib number
- → The Maurten Race Pack will be handed out at the Maurten stand.

Please note: Extras can only be collected during the MARATHON EXPO opening hours

To avoid long waiting times and make your visit as pleasant as possible, we have introduced a system for reserving time slots. Participants have the option of reserving a slot to pick up their bib number. Slots can be booked via your user account until September 15, 2025.



BEFORE THE START

THIS IS WHAT YOU MUST HAVE WITH YOU

- → your personal bib number: attached clearly visible on the chest → may not be altered in any way and is **not** permitted to be given to another person
- → official athletes wristband of the event (which you have received at the MARATHON EXPO)
- → wheelchair athletes & handbiker: Helmet → Helmets are mandatory! Further protective clothing is recommended.



Getting there

Please use public transportation

→ your bib number is valid for public transport in fare zone ABC

Nearby stations

- → Hauptbahnhof (Main station), Friedrichstraße, Brandenburger Tor

Hvdration systems

- To help reduce plastic waste, you can contribute by bringing a hydration system (backpack, vest, belt) to carry your water supply.
 - → Systems with a maximum total volume of 3 liters are permitted
 - → Refills are available at all refreshment and food stations

Own refreshments (only sunday)

- → drop off until 7:45 am at the latest at the "Personal Refreshment stand"
- → glass containers are not allowed
- → mark your container with your name, bib number & refreshment point
 - → delivery to refreshment point at KM 9 / 15 / 20 / 25 / 30 / 36 possible

EVENT SITE

For security reasons only participants with official bib number and athletes wristband are allowed on the event site. Accompanying persons will not be admitted.

Entrance from 7:00 am

- ntrance for Runners opposite the Reichstag (please note the admission times listed below)
- → entrance for Handbiker and Wheelchair athletes via northern pedestrian walkway of Straße des 17. Juni (coming from Victory Column)
- → bags, backpacks and similar are not allowed on the event site
 → exception: hydration systems up to a total volume of 3I

Clothing drop-off

- → Clothes can only be dropped-off in the official, transparent clothing bag of the BMW BERLIN-MARATHON 2025 → will be given to you with your race materials if this option has been booked bindingly with your registration. Otherwise, there is no possibility of leaving things with us.
- Clothing donation: The Berliner Stadtmission collects clothing in good condition. Keep warm in the pre-start zone with a hoodie, tracksuit jacket, etc., and then donate them on site. Important: the collection only takes place at the starting corrals please do not take off your clothes before you reach the corrals.

In the start area you will find changing tents and toilets. There will be no warming foils spent.

START

- → Wheelchair athletes and Handbiker will be assigned to their starting places at 8:30 am
- → runners will start in 4 waves, which are divided in starting groups → you recognize your allocation by the letter on your bib number (A-K) → changes are not possible

Time measurement will be switched off approx. 15 minutes after the last start, which means a late start is not possible.



ON THE COURSE

Not permitted are:

- → accompanying vehicles of any kind
- → strollers or baby joggers, skateboards or other rolling devices (except skates, handbikes and wheelchairs in the respective competitions)
- → animals
- → Please note: Only open-ear headphones are permitted on the course.

 Participants must remain alert at all times and be able to hear important announcements.

Please watch out for fellow participants when you change lanes or approach a refreshment point.

REFRESHMENTS

Start drinking early, especially in warm weather.

- → all points have refill-stations for hydration systems
- → at the end of every refreshment point are toilets available
- Help us to recycle and throw your cup into the containers at the end of the refreshment point.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

- → from KM 15 mobile units with label DOCTOR or MEDICAL SERVICE
- → Every refreshment station has assistance points (Green Cross / First Aid).

→ from KM 36 to the finish: every 1 km accident assistance stations (Green Cross / First Aid)

The medical staff is authorized and obliged to remove participants with signs of injury and/or overexertion from the race. Please contact the staff if you have any complaints or notice any emergencies among others.

TIMEKEEPING

Control points:

→ timing mats are laid out every 5K along the course, all of which must be run over
→ missing split times will result in disqualification

Time limit:

6:15 h for runners (after crossing the start mat)

- → Cut-off point at KM 33 at 3:50 pm
 - → Participants who have not reached this point by that time will be taken off the race and driven to the finish area
- → official finish time is 5:15 pm



AFTER THE FINISH LINE

YOU WILL GET

- → your medal
- > refreshments with drinks and fruit
- → your poncho, if it was booked with your registration
 → your bib number shows a corresponding symbol:
- → OR: your clothing bag on presentation of your bib number until 5:30 pm
- → if needed: warming foil
 - Return the foil to a volunteer after use to help us recycle

In the finish area you will find showers & changing tents (unguarded) and a free massage service.

You got everything?

After leaving the event area, no new access is possible.










BMW BERLIN-MARATHON

Start- & Zielgebiet | Start & Finish Area






BMW BERLIN-MARATHON
